**Medicinal Ingredient:** 1 tablet contains: Dry extract (5–7:1) of *Passiflora incarnata* L. (Passionflower) 425 mg, equivalent to 2.125- 2.975g Passionflower aerial parts. Extractant: ethanol 50 % (V/V).

**Non-Medicinal Ingredients:** Maltodextrin, silica, cellulose powder, croscarmellose sodium, magnesium stearate, stearic acid, talcum, sucrose, calcium carbonate E170, acacia gum, tragacanth, glucose syrup (dry substance), hypromellose, beeswax white, carnauba wax, shellac, colorants: titanium dioxide E171, ferric(III) hydroxide/oxide E172.

**Packaging and Contents:** Original packs of 10, 30, 60, and 100 tablets. Not all package sizes are available.

**Indication:** Traditionally used in Herbal Medicine as a sleep aid (in cases of restlessness or insomnia due to mental stress).

**Dose:** Adults and adolescents 13 years and over: 1 tablet 2 times a day. PASCOFLAIR 425 mg tablet should be swallowed whole with sufficient liquid (preferably a glass of water), and the doses should be spread evenly throughout the day.

**Contraindications:** Contraindicated for patients who are hypersensitive to the active substance or to any of the excipients, patients with a rare hereditary condition known as fructose intolerance, glucose-galactose malabsorption or sucrase-isomaltase deficiency.

**Cautions:** Consult a health care practitioner if symptoms persist or worsen.

Consult a health care practitioner prior to use if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

Consult a health care practitioner if sleeplessness persists continuously for more than 3 weeks (chronic insomnia).

Consumption with alcohol, other medications or natural health products with sedative properties is not recommended.

**Side Effects:** Hypersensitivity (e.g. allergy) has been known to occur; in which case, discontinue use. Some people may experience drowsiness. Exercise caution if operating heavy machinery, driving a motor vehicle or involved in activities requiring mental alertness.

**Note:** Do not use beyond the expiration date indicated on the blister strip and outer label.

**Storage:** Under normal storage conditions. Store away from children.
